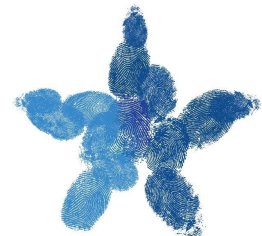

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Call for Applicants

IRIS (Network of CSOs providers of social services) and **Arbeiter-Samariter-Bund Deutschland e.V.** are announcing the Call for participants of the Regional Social Academy, which will be held online from **26-28 October 2020**.

THE FOCUS

The Academy offers participants further support in organizational development - changing the paradigm: moving from traditional organization working as a “machine” to the new organisation working as “organism”. This year Academy will focus on new knowledge and skills of CSOs management and senior staff in agile organizational and project management – impact strategy design and management, agile project management, budgeting, agile leadership and team management, leading the agile organisation, impact measurement and management methodologies and practices.

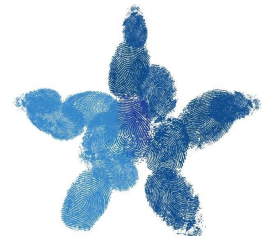
Participants will attend 3-day tailor-made training consisted of online lectures and workshops.

ELIGIBILITY OF THE PARTICIPANTS

Ideal participant should:

- **Be senior in project management** – experienced practitioner and mentor in project management, **or be a member of top or middle management;**
- **Have leadership potential** and be changemaker;
- Be ready and capable and have mandate to **implement new insights in their organization.**

The Academy will be offered in English. **Excellent command and understanding of the English language is precondition to the application.**

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APPLICATION PROCEDURE

In order to apply, **all applicants should fill out the online questionnaire** (please prepare your CV in English to be uploaded) available on the link <https://forms.gle/EY87pSJf6hB4jrRK8>

In total 40 participants will be selected from 5 countries (Albania, Bosnia and Herzegovina, North Macedonia, Montenegro and Serbia). **Deadline for application is 14th of October 2020 at 3 p.m.**

Final participant list **will be announced on the IRIS Network web site on 16th of October.**

FOLLOW UP

Successful participants will obtain certificates, and enter **Academy Alumni**. Upon the training each of the participants will have the opportunity to participate on **Follow-up check-point session** which will be held on 9th of November 2020, online.

BACKGROUND INFORMATION

IRIS network connects more than 200 CSOs, providers of social services from Western Balkan region. Members of the IRIS network provide necessary social and health services to more than 10 000 beneficiaries each day. IRIS aims to strengthen the role of non-profit social service providers throughout SEE and to ensure that these organizations are recognized as equal partners by the public sector. IRIS network was founded in 2012 and from the mere beginning it had a huge support from its partners in the European Union and in the Civil Society Facility program. Through its work IRIS network encourages a consensus among decision-makers, experts and civil society on the needs on effective coordination and use of available local resources and future EU funds earmarked for social inclusion of vulnerable and marginalized groups.

In February 2018, IRIS Network commenced new initiative within the project "IRIS NETWORKING-CSO for protection sensitive migration management" that is focusing on quality of the social service and policy improvement for the migrants in 5 countries of South East Europe (Albania, B&H, North Macedonia, Montenegro and Serbia). Main objective of the project is to empower CSOs to be effective and accountable independent actors and to improve their capacity to dialogue with governments influencing policy and decision-making processes. Project is funded by European Union.

Regional Social Academy is part of the regular IRIS programme activities, organized annually in each of the WB state.
